Firm Partner Brant Stogner Obtains \$10 Million Settlement Following Propane Gas Explosion at Hunting Cabin



Firm attorneys Brant Stogner, Jennifer Stogner, and Jonathan Sneed recently obtained a \$10 million settlement for five hunters who were injured as a result of a residential gas explosion at a cabin in Pecos County on November 30, 2015.

In November 2015, five hunters rented a cabin for their annual hunting trip. During their trip, the hunters realized that the cabin's 250-gallon propane tank used to power appliances was empty or near empty and notified the cabin's owners. The owners then contacted a large gas supply company to refill the propane tank, and a technician was sent to refill the tank at the hunting cabin. However, the technician did not perform a leak check on the cabin's gas system to make sure it was secure and free of leaks. The explosion occurred just one day later.

Firm Partner Mo Aziz Files Lawsuit Against Fortune 500 Transportation Company for Crash That Led to Double Leg Amputation

Firm attorneys Mo Aziz, Karl Long, and Angelina Wike filed a lawsuit against J.B. Hunt Transport, Inc. and Cory Munson on behalf of Abdullah Baidas who sustained catastrophic injuries after falling over an overpass in Houston on Friday, April 10, 2020.



The incident occurred when Baidas and others were stopped on I-45 near Rankin Road when a tractor trailer, being driven by Cody Munson, that was owned and operated by J.B. Hunt Transport, Inc., slammed

into the disabled vehicles and their occupants and caused Baidas to fall off the overpass. Baidas dropped at least 10 to 15 feet from the overpass which caused him to suffer catastrophic injuries, including the double amputation of his legs.
