TWO FIRM PARTNERS SERVE AS PRESIDENT-ELECTS DURING SAME BAR YEAR



Firm Partners Randy Sorrels and Benny Agosto, Jr. are both serving as President-Elects during the 2018-2019 bar year. In the spring, Mr. Sorrels was elected the President-Elect of the State Bar of Texas, and Mr. Agosto was elected the President-Elect of the Houston Bar Association. Mr. Agosto took office as President-Elect of the Houston Bar Association at the HBA's Annual Dinner on Thursday, May 17, 2018 in Houston. In addition to practicing law, Mr. Agosto also serves the community through positions held in national and statewide organizations. Mr. Agosto is a former President of the Hispanic National Bar Association and is the Founder and President of the Mexican-American Bar Association of Texas Foundation, which organizes scholarships annually for Hispanic law students in Houston.
